In 1954, the Air Force Reserve was experiencing problems with its flying programs and decided
to move some of its allocated positions to Guard units. That October, the 8104th Replacement

Squadron was formed to accommodate the additional personnel and Maj. Victor Kilkowski was selected to command the new unit. The unit was comprised of 25 pilots and 75 maintenance troops. Members of the 8104th worked seamlessly with the members of the 104th Fighter

Squadron and its attached units and for all practical purposes, there was no division between the units.
The creation of this unit proved fortuitous when the new 135th Air Resupply Squadron was formed the next year, creating a demand for many more personnel.
