HQ, General Headquarters Air Force (1933-36)

Constituted in the Regular Army on 1 October 1933 as Headquarters, General Headquarters Air Force and partially organized at Langley Field, VA, with personnel and assets from the demobilized 1st Bombardment Brigade Headquarters. Transferred on 28 February 1934 to Bolling Field, DC. Transferred on 28 February 1935 to Langley Field, VA. Redesignated Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, General Headquarters Air Force on 1 March 1935 and fully activated. Transferred on 29 March 1941 to Bolling Field, DC. Redesignated Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, Air Force Combat Command on 1 July 1941.
