The activation of ESS was an operational action which directly corresponded to ESC's expanding role in providing support and services to the operational Major Commands (MAJCOM). The 6949th Electronic Security Group (ESG) at Offutt AFB redesignated as the 6949th Electronic Security Squadron (ESS), and the 6949 ESS; 6985 ESS, Eielson AFB, Alaska; and OL-FE, Offutt AFB were assigned to HQ ESS. The 6985 ESS was later reassigned to the newly established HQ Electronic Security, Alaska (ESA) on 1 Oct 1983 to eliminate the split management of ESC's Alaskan units.
