EMBLEM

Azure, above in base a globe Silver Gray, gridlined and charged with a key fesswise ward downward to dexter of the field, in saltire a dagger, point to dexter base blade Argent, grip and guard of the second, detailed and fimbriated Sable, and a stylized delta Or, detailed bendwise of the second and Gules, parted and fimbriated of the fifth, its contrail a lightning flash of the last, fimbriated of the sixth, all within a diminished bordure of the fifth. Attached below the shield, a White scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "GLOBAL EXPLOITATION

INTEL GROUP" in Blue letters. **SIGNIFICANCE** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The key within the globe represents the Group's intelligence expertise, signifying its disciplines in intelligence analysis and production—the ability to unlock adversary secrets. The cross formed by the dagger and the delta alludes to the Group's mission. The delta and stylized lightning bolt contrail is derived from NASIC's emblem, with gridded upper half signifying the exploitation of foreign aerospace weapons systems, the lower half alluding to the acquisition of foreign weapon systems and the contrail representing a mission rooted in wireless communication analysis. The dagger represents the unit's military preparedness towards its world-wide mission: always ready – anytime, anyplace.
