Constituted in the Regular Army 22 December 1939 as Base Headquarters and 19th Air Base Squadron (1 Group) and allotted to the Ninth Corps Area. Organized on 1 February 1940 at Hamilton Field, CA, as Base Headquarters and 19th Air Base Squadron (Single). Transferred on 1 June 1940 to McChord Field, WA. Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1940 as HHS, 19th Air Base Group. Disbanded 1 April 1943.
