Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1936 as Base Headquarters and 9th Air Base Squadron and assigned to the Ninth Corps Area. Relieved from the Ninth Corps Area 15 November 1939 and assigned to the General Headquarters Air Force. Redesignated on 6 December 1939 as Base Headquarters and 9th Air Base Squadron (1 Group). Redesignated on 1 February 1940 as Base Headquarters and 9th Air Base Squadron (Single). Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1940 as HHS, 9th Air Base Group (Special). Disbanded 25 April 1944.
