After only three years, ATC inactivated the Special Treatment Center at Lackland AFB on 15 May. The Air Force had originally established the center in 1971 to provide psychiatric evaluation and behavioral reorientation for airmen with drug problems. However, as the war in Southeast Asia wound down and individual bases became more proficient in their rehabilitation efforts, the center's workload declined. Therefore, ATC suggested and the Air Staff approved the transfer of those services to the 3415th Special Training Group at Lowry

AFB.
