USAF HQ decided to collocate all Air Force intelligence training at Goodfellow AFB, and ATC designated the base Goodfellow Technical Training Center on 1 March 1985.

During 1985, a new era in intelligence training began at Goodfellow Air Force Base, Texas, with the transfer of the Electronics Intelligence Operations Specialist Course from Keesler Air Force Base, Miss. This transfer represented the first in a series of moves designed to consolidate intelligence training at the Goodfellow Technical Training Center.

The ELINT "205" operator course was moved from Keesler AFB to Goodfellow in November 1985. The next decade brought additional training and changes to Goodfellow, including the development of three revised intelligence courses for officers and the transfer of the Air Force firefighting school from Chanute AFB, Illinois, to Goodfellow.
